_____/7_ Includes a hand-drawn map of country on an 8 by 11-inch piece of paper. Includes the capital, major cities, bodies of water, rivers, and major geographical features of your country. Labels neighboring bodies of water and countries. Map fills up entire piece of paper.

_____/5_ Includes a hand-drawn flag of country on an 8 by 11-inch piece of paper. Flag takes up the entire 8 By 11-inch piece of paper. Colors and design are accurate. Contains explanation of colors and symbols.

_____/4_ Followed typing and page set-up directions (350 words, 12-pt Times New Roman, double spaced)
