Problems 1-5. Identify each statement as *hypothetical*, *indefinite*, or *singular* by circling the correct choice. Then translate the statement into categorical form. **Remember the 3 rules for categorical statements!**

1. I am a PEP student. HYPOTHETICAL INDEFINITE SINGULAR

2. If you see this creature, then you will run away. HYPOTHETICAL INDEFINITE SINGULAR

3. Flowers are blooming in my yard. HYPOTHETICAL INDEFINITE SINGULAR

4. Brutus assassinated Caesar. HYPOTHETICAL INDEFINITE SINGULAR

5. Screams were heard in the street. HYPOTHETICAL INDEFINITE SINGULAR

Problems 6-9. For each statement, write two equivalent immediate inferences. Identify each immediate inference as *converse*, *obverse*, or *contrapositive*.

6. No plumbers are artists.

7. Some people are accountants.

8. Some amphibians are not frogs.

9. All tyrants are evil men.

10. Using immediate inferences, translate this argument into a standard categorical syllogism.
“No Christians are unredeemed. Therefore, all non-Christians are unsanctified, since all redeemed people are sanctified.”

Problems 11-14: Translate the given statement into standard categorical form.

11. Only those who study hard will pass the test.

12. You should buy whatever you want.

13. Everyone can ride except the adults.

14. She never eats her vegetables.

Problem 15. Translate the argument into a standard categorical syllogism. Do not abbreviate.

15. God saves whoever trusts in Him. Judas was not saved. Thus, Judas never trusted in God.

EXTRA CREDIT!! Translate the following into a standard categorical syllogisms. Do not abbreviate.

1. Only jets are supersonic. So not every Navy plane is supersonic, since some Navy planes are not jets.

Translate the following into a categorical statement. Remember the 3 Rules!

2. Anyone who thinks welfare helps people doesn't know what he's talking about.

3. Someone should do something about the size of the government.

4. A foolish son is the heaviness of his mother. (Prov. 10:1)
