



Latin I, II Roman Empire Poster Project

The goal of this project is to increase your understanding of the culture of the Roman Empire by creating a poster of a topic of your choice. You will present your poster to the class on Tuesday, April 23.

Please research your topic thoroughly before beginning your poster!

Then use a regular sized poster board of any color to fill with pictures or drawings that will inform the class about your topic. Be sure to put the name of your topic at the top of your poster board. Please use a minimum of 8 pictures on your poster. You will need to label each picture, either by typing or using very neat handwriting. Typing is preferable.

You will also need to include at least 8 Latin words on your poster that accurately name the items in your pictures/drawings. For example, if your topic is Roman foods, then you will want to label the Latin name of at least 8 of the food items on your poster. If your topic is uniforms of Roman soldiers, then you will want to give the Latin names for 8 of the items included in the uniform on your poster.

Your project will count as a test grade and will be graded using the rubric below:
