2. for a new ally (use *socius*, *-ī*) (Dat. s.)
3. holy statues (Acc. pl.)
4. of the sweet babies (use *īnfāns*, *īnfāntis*) (Gen. pl.)
5. by the silent man (use *vir*) (Abl. s.)
6. noble ships (Acc. pl.)
7. difficult leader (Nom. s.)
8. for the unhappy scribes (Dat. pl.)
9. of every year (Gen. s.)
10. cruel sailor (Acc. s.)
