5. by the deceitful young man (Abl. s.)
6. powerful fires (Nom pl.)
7. to the cheap man (use *homō, hominis*) (Abl. s.)
8. for the silent nights (Dat. pl.)
9. of the unsightly city (Gen. s.)
10. short night (Acc. s.)
